Entry Procedures — to enter your cat(s) in competition, go to the website: feb.evergreencatfanciers.org. Click on the header “Enter the Show” and follow the instructions. Fill out Summary sheet on website. Send payment within 24 hours. Then go to the TOES online entry system via the link on the website and enter your cat(s).

Show Hall — The show will be held at the Ferndale Events Center, located at 5715 Barrett Road, Ferndale, WA 98248. Phone: 800-449-4393. Club member made lunches will be available for purchase. However, we recommend that you pre-pay on the summary sheet. Cat litter will be provided for the show hall. Bring your own cat food, food dishes and litter pans.

Show Hours — **Saturday check-in: 8:30am-9:30am with show starting at 10:00am.** Sunday check-in: 8:00-8:30am with show starting at 9:00am. Advertised Show Hours: Sat 10am-5pm; Sun 9am-4pm.

Directions to Ferndale Events Center: (from the North) Take Interstate 5 South. Take Exit 262 (Axton Road). Turn left on Axton Road. Go one block. Take a left on Barrett (by McDonalds). The Ferndale Events Center is on the left. **(from the South)** Take Interstate 5 North. Take Exit 262 (Axton Road). Turn left on Axton Road. Go one block. Turn left on Barrett. The Ferndale Events Center is on the left.

Airport Information — You have two choices of airports — The closest airport is Bellingham International Airport (BLI) which is 6 miles from the show hall and hotel. The other option is Sea-Tac International Airport (SEA), which is 85 miles south of Ferndale. **With advance request, Club will provide free pickup/drop off at Bellingham (BLI) airport ONLY.**

Show Hotel — Our show hotel is the **Best Western Heritage Inn** is located at 151 East McLeod Road, Bellingham, WA 98226 -5520, about 8 minutes south of the Ferndale and just 3.5 miles from the Bellingham International Airport. Phone 360-647-1912 or toll free 1-800-780-7234; *Room rate is \$99.00 for single or double occupancy. Pet fee waived! Free shuttle to/from Bellingham Airport.* To get the above rate, you must book your reservation no later than **Friday, January 24, 2020 at the following link: https://www.bestwestern.com/en_US/book/hotel-rooms.48090.html?groupid=E55NN184**.

The hotel has free wi-fi high-speed internet access, free breakfast, free local calls, free parking, business center, indoor swimming pool, and fitness center. Take extra care to clean up litter, food and other spills. Protect the rooms from spraying cats by confining them in cages or keeping them in the bathroom. Exhibitors staying at the Best Western Heritage Inn agree to abide by TICA’s Hotel Room Inspection Policy.

The club will provide free shuttle to/from the hotel and show hall, if prearranged!

JE's who are currently in TICA's JE program are eligible to receive the special JE entry rate. Each JE entry includes a regular show entry and double cage. Show Photographer — We are pleased to announce that Chanan (Richard Katris) will be the show photographer.

Benching Request: Only one benching request will be allowed. **If you list more than one, only the first request will be considered.** Handicapped exhibitors will receive preferential and "free" end-of-row benching, if requested. All other end-of-row request will be benched on a first-come, first-served, space available basis at a cost of \$15.00. Entry clerk will make every attempt to bench your cats per your request, however, the club does not guarantee that all benching requests can be honored due to space limitations and show hall configuration.

Cage size: The club's cages are 21" tall, 21" deep, and 45" wide and has a 3" divider in the middle which can be easily be used as one large cage or it can be split into 2 cages if you need to separate multiple cats. Every 'odd numbered' entry includes a double cage space. Benching is sold in increments of double cage space only!

Personal cages: If you use a personal cage, and it is wider than 45", you must also purchase a groom space to accommodate the extra width. The maximum depth for a personal cage is 24" deep. If your cage is deeper than 24", it will not fit on our 24" deep tables. If you plan to use your personal cage, please note this on the summary sheet.

Other Cage Requirements: The top, floor, sides, and back of the cage must be covered. Per TICA rules, only one cat or two kittens per 1/2 double cage, and two cats or four kittens per double cage.

Exhibition/For Sale cages are \$45. These are double cages and are available to exhibitors who have at least one cat entered for competition, provided space is available. You must complete an entry form for each kitten or cat for sale and on exhibition; All cats/kittens must be listed in the exhibitor catalog. No exceptions! No cat or kitten will be allowed in the show hall if it is not listed in the catalog. No sales will be allowed from carriers. If you are bringing cat(s) for sale, you MUST comply with all TICA rules regarding maximum numbers allowed (i.e., no more than 2 adults or 4 kittens in a double cage).

Ring Clerks/Stewards — Clerks will receive lunch plus **\$40** for each full day of clerking. Clerks will be paid after clerking, please do not deduct clerking fees from your entry form. Preference will be given to those in the TICA clerking program. The Club is also in need of good stewards for the show. Stewards will receive lunch plus \$20/ring for each full day of stewarding.

Show Catalogs — One show catalog is included free with your first entry. Additional show catalogs are \$5 each. No catalogs will be available for sale in the show hall. The show committee accepts no responsibility for catalog errors due to illegibility or mistakes on the entry form.

Kitten Age Requirements — To compete, kittens must be **4 calendar months old** — must have been born **on or before October 8, 2019**. To be allowed in the show hall, kittens must be **3 calendar months old** — must have been born **on or before November 8, 2019**. **Note:** If the Entry Clerk requests, a TICA litter registration must be provided at the time of entry. Any kitten without proof of age will not be entered in the show, nor will it be allowed in the show hall.

Household Pets (HHP's)— HHP Kittens (4 to 8 months old) do NOT need to be altered. HHPs over 8 months of age must be altered (neutered or spayed). Please phone the entry clerk if you are not sure how to describe your cat's color, or if you have any questions about how to fill out the entry form.

Preliminary New Breeds and Advanced New Breeds— According to TICA Show Rule 203.19, all Preliminary New Breeds (PNB) and Advanced New Breeds (ANB) must have a TICA registration number prior to entering any TICA show. No PNB or ANB may enter a show with a "registration pending" status.

Registration—Registration with TICA is not necessary to compete in the cat's first show, but is required for the 2nd and subsequent shows for confirmation of championships and TICA regional and international awards. Contact the TICA Executive Office for specific registration procedures.

Liability— The Evergreen Cat Fanciers, TICA, the City of Ferndale, The Ferndale Events Center, and the contracted show hotel(s), will not be held liable for injury, loss or damage to cats, exhibitors, property of exhibitors, vendors or other such persons or property in attendance.

Health — This is a non-vetted show. Every cat that enters the show hall must conform to normally accepted health requirements and be up-to-date on its vaccinations. Front and back claws must be clipped. Cats from households with contagious or infectious illnesses within the last 21 days are ineligible for entry. *Cats with suspected contagious or infectious illness or with parasites will be removed from the show hall.*

Show Rules — All exhibitors agree to abide by and uphold the show rules of TICA. Show rules and registration information are available from TICA, PO Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551, (956) 428-8046 or from the TICA website: www.tica.org

Other Important Club Rules — With the exception of cats available for adoption by rescue organizations, no other cats or kittens are allowed in the show hall unless they are listed in the official show catalog. No cat or kitten sales are allowed from carriers.
